... if you have checked the most recent recall list?

... that a safety belt shoulder strap should not be placed under the arm? And why not?

... when a child is old enough to ride forward facing in the car and how California law has changed?

... how to properly transport physically challenged infants, children, and adults in vehicles?

... what a tether strap is and why it is very important?

These are a few of the essential points covered in this workshop, which prepares professionals and community volunteers to prevent injuries in traffic collisions, the #1 cause of death and disability for children and adults 35 years of age and under.

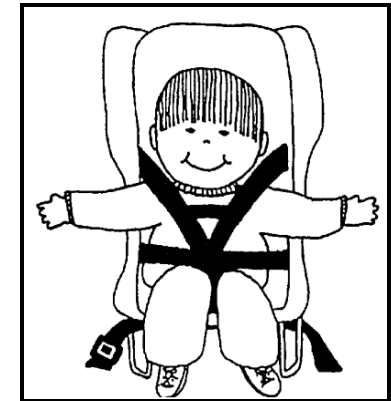
