... what a tether strap is and why it is very important?

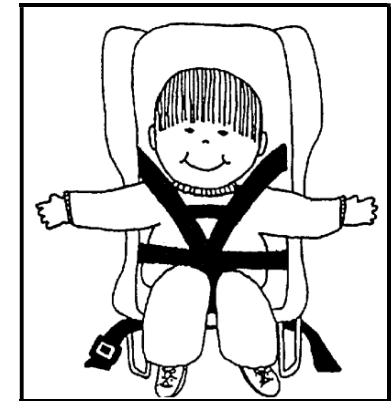

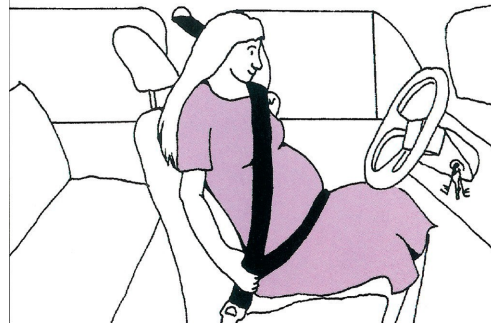
