... what a tether strap is and why it is so important?

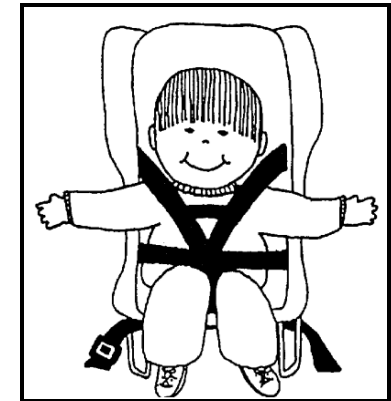

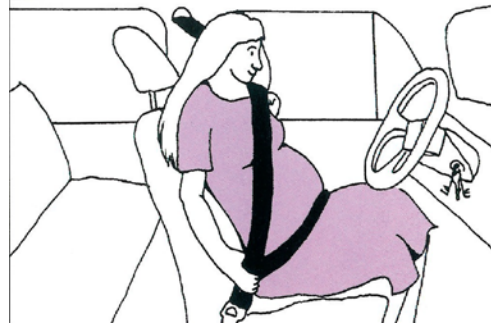
